On motion by COUN. JANIUS M. YASAY and unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED, to pass and approve, Resolution No. 19 containing therein Ordinance No. 1 S. 2016, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 01
SERIES 2016

“AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING DRESS CODE AND IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM FOR DRIVERS OF MOTORIZED TRANSPORT VEHICLES PLYING THEIR ROUTE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AS AMENDED.”

Section 1. Statutory Provisions.

Drivers of Motorized Transport Vehicles are, by this Municipal Ordinance required to dress in a manner that would give dignity to their vocation, add some measure of respectability to their person and give a semblance of order among their ranks through the use of Identification Cards.

- 1.A Dress Code — T-Shirts or Polo Shirts of any color will do except those whose Sleeves have been torn off and other Sleeveless Underwear that would expose a good part of the shoulders and armpits. Long Pants or Cargo Shorts (Denim or Maong) and Shoes or Strapped Sandals shall complete the ensemble.
- 1.B Optional Color Schemes — The Tricycle Drivers/Operators' Association may, on their initiative, prescribe the color of T-Shirts for Drivers according to specific route or district.

II.A Motorized Transport Vehicles — are three-wheeled motorized vehicles assembled conveniently out of an enclosed Side-Car and a Motorbike for passenger transport purposes.

II.B Identification System — are Identification Cards in plastic jackets or lamination in

plastic bearing the driver's photo, home address, name of association and community tax number, conspicuously attached on his shirt or inside his vehicle for easy identification by the riding public.

Section III. Penalty Clause.

Thirty (30) days upon approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, this Municipal Ordinance shall take effect. Sanctions for violation of any of the provisions of this Code shall be as follows:
