**RESOLUTION NO. 29-2016**

On motion presented by COUN.JANIUS M. YASAY and unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED, to approve & adopt, Resolution No. 29-2016 containing therein Ordinance No. 3, to wit:

**ORDINANCE NO. 03  
SERIES OF 2016**

**“AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF HUMPS ALONG PROVINCIAL, MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY ROADS IN MONCADA.”**

**Preamble:** It is the policy of the State to ensure the safety and convenience of Motorists and Pedestrians alike using public roads as travel and transport routes at all times.

**Section 1. Title.**

**“THE ILLEGAL HUMPS ORDINANCE OF MONCADA 2016.”**

**Section 2. Definition of Terms:**

- 1) Humps – for purposes of this Ordinance are man-made protuberances constructed or laid across a street or road in the municipality, purposely to keep vehicles from speeding and ultimately avoiding accidents.
- 2) Provincial, Barangay and Municipal Roads – are travel and transport routes within the community registered as such under the jurisdiction of local authorities.

**Section 3. Statutory Provisions:**

- A. Humps of any nature and material constructed or laid across provincial, municipal and barangay roads within the municipality are hereby prohibited.
- B. However, humps may be constructed or laid across provincial, municipal and barangay roads provided these are at or within the vicinity of schools, health facilities, churches or places of worship, parks and playgrounds, trading centers and barangay halls.

- C. Existing humps on provincial, barangay and municipal roads not specifically situated in areas provided in Section III sub-section B of this ordinance are deemed hazards rather than precautionary means to avoid accidents that must be removed for faster, smoother, safer and convenient travel.
- D. Barangay Officials, in whose juridical areas such road humps may have been constructed or laid across, shall be responsible for removing the same in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.
- E. Construction of humps of concrete and asphalt shall abide by the following specifications for maximum safety and convenience to motorists and pedestrians alike.
  - 1. Humps shall have a uniform height of 8 cms. at its highest center point, gradually sloping down its base width of 45 cms. at road level.
  - 2. Humps shall be painted in standard striped black and yellow and must have a reflectorized or translucent effect, especially during night time.
- F. Construction of humps on provincial, municipal and barangay roads in specified areas allowed under the Code shall be under the direct supervision of the Provincial and Municipal Engineer and assisted by Barangay Officials.
- G. Construction cost for labor and materials in setting up the humps as allowed in this Ordinance shall be shouldered by the Municipal Government for Municipal Roads and the Barangay Council for Barangay Roads.

#### **Section 4. Penalty Provision.**

Persons responsible in the construction, setting up or laying across of humps of any material or form on subject roads other than the areas specified in this Code shall be hailed to Court for violation of its provisions.

#### **Section 5. Effectivity Clause.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

In any case that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan fails to act on this Ordinance after ten-10 working days from receipt thereof, the same shall be deemed approved and therefore given the legal basis for implementation.
