**RESOLUTION NO. 09-2005**

On motion presented and unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED, to pass & approve, Resolution No. 09-2005 containing therein Ordinance No. 1, series of 2005, to wit:

**ORDINANCE NO. 1  
SERIES 2005**

**“AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF VIDEOKE MACHINES  
WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONCADA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR  
VIOLATIONS HEREOF.”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MONCADA, TARLAC IN  
SESSION ASSEMBLED:

**Section 1. Title of the Ordinance:**

This ordinance shall be known as **“THE SOUND POLLUTION ORDINANCE OF  
MONCADA, TARLAC.”**

**Section 2. Definition of Terms:**

- a. **Videoke-** a machine that projects televised images corresponding to a muted song that is meant to be sung.
- b. **Sound Pollution-** a state of disturbance in the atmosphere caused by noise or humanly intolerable sounds.
- c. **Volume-** degree of loudness or intensity of a sound.
- d. **Tolerable-** moderately good.
- e. **Commercial Video Machine-** video machines intended for business purposes with the end earning profit for the owner or proprietor.

**Section 3. Statutory Provisions:**

- a. Every person has the right to operate a videoke machine after securing a permit from the Local Government Unit, provided, that operators shall observe prescribed rules and limitations and respect the rights of others.
- b. Commercial Videoke Machines shall be turned on from 10:00 A.M. up to 10:00 P.M.
- c. That the volume emanating from these machines should be reduced to a tolerable level starting at 7:00 P.M.
- d. That the videoke machines must be installed 100 meters away from schools, churches, hospitals, medical clinics, public offices, public buildings and national shrines and 20 meters away from the nearest house within a high density residential zone.
- e. During birthdays or wakes and other occasions, commercial or non-commercial videoke machines maybe allowed within the residential area provided, the same shall be strictly supervised by the Barangay Officials.
- f. Non-commercial videoke machines intended for home use only may be exempted from the other provisions of this ordinance.

**Section 4. Penalty Clause:**

Any person or operator who violates this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- 1) **First Offense**- A reprimand
- 2) **Second Offense**- Revocation of the permit to operate the videoke machine.

**Section 5.** The Barangay Officials and the PNP shall be the enforcement monitoring agencies of said ordinance.

**Section 6. Repealing Clause:**

Any existing municipal ordinance inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended.

**Section 7. Effectivity Clause:**

This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after a copy on the Municipal Bulletin Board and at least two (2) conspicuous places in the municipality shall been posted.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished all concerned upon securing Mayor’s Permit for their information and guidance.
