RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MONCADA, TARLAC, THROUGH THE HONORABLE MAYOR ESTELITA M. AQUINO, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FIELD OFFICE III FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONCADA

WHEREAS, the Supplementary Feeding Program (SFP) is the provision of food in addition to the regular meals to target children ages 2-5 years old enrolled in the Child Development Center (CDCs) and Supervised Neighborhood Play (SNPs) as part of the DSWD's contribution to the early childhood care and development (ECCD) program of the government;

WHEREAS, under the Section 4(a) of RA No. 11037 or the "Masustansyang Pagkain Para sa Batang Pilipino Act," the DSWD, in coordination with the LGUs, has been tasked to implement a SFP for undernourished children with ages three (3) to five (5) years which shall include the provision of at least one (1) fortified meal for a period of not less than one hundred twenty (120) days in a year;

WHEREAS, the General Appropriation Act of 2022 stated that the target outcome indicator of SFP is 80% of malnourished children in CDCs and SNPs with improved nutritional status;

WHEREAS, given the limitation in the purchasing power of most families due to extended effect of the COVID-19 pandemic and inflation of food commodities, SFP implementation shall assist in addressing the issue of hunger and food security

among Filipino children and prevent regression of the current nutritional status of the beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of RA No. 11321 otherwise known as the "Sagip Saka Act states that the National and Local Government Agencies shall directly purchase agricultural and fishery products from farmers and fisher folk cooperatives and enterprises provided that the said agricultural and fishery products are necessary in the performance of their respective mandates. The procurement by the national and local government agencies shall be exempt from the application of the bidding process prescribed under relevant government procurement laws provided that said agencies shall undergo a negotiated procurement under the applicable guidelines of the Government Procurement Policy Board;

WHEREAS, the DSWD adopted alternative modes of implementation such as distribution of dry rations, nutripacks, and nutritubun with fresh milk to address issues on the continuous delivery of services despite the shift of the ECCD sessions from face to face to virtual learning;

WHEREAS, LGUs, as partners of the DSWD in the expeditious delivery of the social amelioration program, shall also assist in the implementation of SFP;


NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, and on motion by Coun. Alberto C. Marzan, Jr., duly seconded;

RESOLVED, that this Sanggunian, acting on the favorable recommendation of the Committee on Health and Social Welfare, hereby authorizes the Municipal Government of Moncada, Tarlac, through the Honorable Mayor Estelita M. Aquino, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) for the implementation of supplementary feeding program in the Municipality of Moncada;
