RESOLUTION ADOPTING “KasamaKa” AS A NATIONAL GRASSROOTS-BASED PROGRAM FOR FINANCIAL INCLUSION AND SOCIAL ADVOCACY IN ACCELERATING FINANCIAL LITERACY AND INCLUSIVE GROWTH IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONCADA, TARLAC

WHEREAS, “KasamaKA” is a social initiative and advocacy to accelerate inclusive growth in the country by enabling unbanked and underserved Filipinos, which comprise sixty nine percent (69%) of the population, to be part of the formal financial system, and hasten the Philippines’ digital transformation to bring about an inclusive digital economy, spearheaded by FINTQnologies Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of Voyager Innovations, Inc., under the PLDT Group;

WHEREAS, President Duterte in his speech at the KasamaKA National Financial Inclusion Network Launch during the Disruptors’ Ball held on February 18, 2018 said, *“In the end, the development of our economy lies greatly in part on how inclusive our financial programs are. This is why I thank FINTQnologies Corp. for supporting the government’s goal of financial inclusion and for adopting user-friendly technology in the provision of financial services to our people. I welcome the KasamaKA initiative as an effective way to realize our agenda of inclusive growth. Hopefully, this movement will make productive capital more easily accessible to the common “tao” and equip them to start any enterprise they wish to pursue. Let me underscore that the government is committed to reduce poverty through financial inclusion. We shall provide all-out support to our private sector partners who are contributing to this Administration’s economic thrusts, in general, and to financial inclusion, in particular. Encourage key stakeholders to become our partners for change as we foster a more sustainable and inclusive economy. Let us renew our commitment in the fight against poverty and ensure the Filipino people a more comfortable and financially independent life. KasamaKA, kasama tayong lahat!”*;





compliant micro financing), credit, and pension among others, to veer our respective constituents away from predatory lenders or 5-6 operators in support of President Rodrigo Roa Duterte's initiative to reduce poverty by 2020.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to perform the following acts by way of promoting inclusive digital finance in support of the government's National Strategy for Financial Inclusion and the National Retail Payments System:

1. Encourage grassroots participation in KasamaKA as a national movement for financial inclusion and social advocacy for accelerating inclusive growth by engaging all cities, municipalities and barangays to identify their own City, Municipal and Barangay KasamaKA Community Leader (KCL). The designated KCL shall be responsible for facilitating the voluntary participation of their respective constituents in the Project;
2. Take the primary role in the information dissemination campaign and assisting in the regular financial education and literacy programs during local events and assemblies with the assistance of the KasamaKA National Coordinating Team.
3. Identify sari-sari stores to be enhanced as Barangay Digital Community Centers (BDCCs) which would be the first mile customer touch point for digital financial services;
4. Implement KasamaKA capacity-building and values formation programs and projects for all its cities, municipalities and barangays nationwide enabling greater digital access to finance as well as to serve as the central communication hub for local government announcements;
5. Mobilize its network in creating massive awareness by developing and conducting sustainable financial education campaigns thereby empowering cities and municipalities;
6. Help the government, especially the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas in its vision, by leapfrogging digital financial transactions in the country from the current one (1) percent of 2.5 billion monthly financial transactions worth US\$74 Billion to a minimum of 20 percent by year 2020, by harnessing financial innovations thereby creating a cash-lite and digital economy for greater efficiency, security, transparency, interoperability, and affordability;


RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the Honorable Mayor Estelita M. Aquino and all concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.

Adopted unanimously by the Sangguniang Bayan members during the regular session on May 15, 2018 at the SB Session Hall, Legislative Building, Moncada, Tarlac.




