RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MONCADA, THROUGH THE HONORABLE ESTELITA M. AQUINO, MUNICIPAL MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FIELD OFFICE III FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY SUBSIDY PROGRAM (ESP) PURSUANT TO BAYANIHAN TO RECOVER AS ONE ACT (RA 11494)

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic and simultaneous community quarantines have caused severe disruption in economic activities all over the country affecting the means of livelihood of low-income households, including senior citizens, pregnant and lactating women, solo parents, distressed overseas Filipinos, persons with disability, indigenous peoples, underprivileged and homeless families and informal economy workers;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the enactment of Republic Act 11494, otherwise known as the "Bayanihan to Recover as One Act of 2020", an intensified government response is adopted whereby the national government will render assistance to the LGUs and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake appropriate measures to curtail the effects of the pandemic on the economic, physical and psychosocial well-being of the most affected population;

WHEREAS, under Section 4 (f)(1) and (f)(3) of RA 11494, the DSWD is mandated to provide emergency subsidy of P5,000.00 to P8,000.00 to low income households placed under granular lockdown, to households with recently returned and undocumented OFW and to low-income households which are qualified to receive, under Section 4(c) of RA 11494, but were not granted the same;

WHEREAS, in light of the unabated spread of COVID-19 in the country and the extension of State of Calamity until September 12, 2021, the DSWD and LGUs shall extensively collaborate to undertake the efficient, safe and proper delivery of emergency subsidy and the social services identified in RA 11494;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing premises, the DSWD enters into a Memorandum of Agreement with the LGU of Moncada for the transfer of funds to the latter for purposes of facilitating the distribution of assistance to qualified beneficiaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, and on motion by Coun. Alberto C. Marzan, Jr., seconded by Coun. Cleofe D. Favis;

RESOLVED, that this Sanggunian, acting on the favorable recommendation of the Committee on Health and Social Services and Committee on Finance, Ways and Means and Appropriations, hereby authorizes the Municipal Government of Moncada, through the Honorable Estelita M. Aquino, Municipal Mayor, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Social Welfare and Development Field Office III for the implementation of Emergency Subsidy Program (ESP) pursuant to Bayanihan To Recover As One Act (RA 11494);

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the Honorable Estelita M. Aquino, Municipal Mayor, the Department of Social Welfare and Development Field Office III and all concerned agencies and offices for their appropriate action;
