RESOLUTION NO. 3

On motion presented by Kgd. ZOSIMO B. CUCHAPIN & unanimously seconded;

RESOLVED, to pass & approve, as it is hereby passed and approved, Resolution No. 3 s. 1998 containing therein ordinance no. 1, to wit:

ORDINANCE No. 1

“AN ORDINANCE AGAINST LITTERING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF”

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNINANG BAYAN MEMBERS IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

-THAT-

Section 1. The title of this ordinance shall be known as Anti Littering Ordinance of 1998.

Section 2. To promote and maintain cleanliness, health and sanitation for the general welfare of the inhabitants, there is a compelling need of the Municipal Government to take positive and effective measures to guard against littering.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to strew, litter, dump or throw garbage, refuse, rubbish, other filth and domestic wastes in any public roads or streets or highways, public places or parks, government buildings and their premises and in any municipal waters and canals.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful to urinate or to defecate in any public places except in intended urinals and toilets.

Section 5. Owners of restaurants and other eateries, tricycle operators, sidewalk vendors engaged in the business of selling foods, retail stores and fishmongers shall provide their own cans or garbage receptacles for their own use as well as for the use of their customers. Violation hereof shall constitute a ground for the suspension or revocation of their business license or permit.

Section 6. Any violations of the ordinance shall be punishable with:

- a) Imprisonment of 5 days or a fine of ₱ 100.00 or both at the discretion of the court for the first offense;
- b) Imprisonment of 10 days or a fine of ₱ 200.00 or both at the discretion of the court for the second offense;
- c) Imprisonment of 20 days or a fine of ₱ 300.00 or both at the discretion of the court for the third and subsequent offenses.

Section 7. A person under nine (9) years of age is exempt from any liability for any infraction of the ordinance. Likewise, a person over nine years of age but under fifteen is exempt from any liability unless he acted with discernment.

Section 8. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days following the completion of its posting at a conspicuous place of the Municipal Building.
