RESOLVED, to pass & approve, Resolution No. 27-2003 containing therein
Ordinance No. 2 S. 2003, to wit:

**ORDINANCE No. 2
SERIES 2003**

**“AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SEGREGATION OF BIODEGRADABLE AND NON-
BIODEGRADABLE WASTES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATORS
THEREOF.”**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNINANG BAYAN OF MONCADA,
TARLAC IN SESSION ASSEMBLED;**

-THAT-

Section 1. Title.

The title of the ordinance shall be known as **“BIODEGRADABLE AND NON-
BIODEGRADABLE WASTE SEGREGATION ORDINANCE OF 2003.”**

Section 2. Definition of Terms:

- 1) Biodegradable- a substance capable of natural decomposition into harmless elements in a short period.
- 2) Non-Biodegradable- any substance not capable of decomposition.

Section 3. To promote and maintain cleanliness and to provide for an efficient and effective system of garbage collection and disposal, there is a compelling need for

the Municipal Government to take positive and effective measures to impose segregation of Biodegradable and Non-Biodegradable Wastes.

Section 4. Owners of restaurants and other eateries, tricycle operators, ambulant vendors, engaged in the business of selling foods, retail stores, groceries or any business establishments shall provide their own garbage receptacles for Biodegradable and Non-Biodegradable Wastes. Violations hereof shall continue a ground for suspension of their Business Permit.

Section 5. It shall unlawful to dump household wastes in garbage receptacles for collection without segregating the Biodegradable from the Non-Biodegradable.

Section 6. Unsegregated garbage will not be collected.

Section 7. Penalty.

Any violation of the ordinance shall be punishable with:

- 1) First Offense- Imprisonment of one (1) day or a fine of not more than P100.00 or both or Community Service for two (2) hours at the discretion of the Court.
- 2) Second Offense- Imprisonment of two (2) days or a fine of not more than P300.00 but not less than P100.00 or both or Community Service for three (3) hours at the discretion of the Court.
- 3) Third and Subsequent Offenses- Imprisonment of three (3) days or a fine of not more than P500.00 but not less than P500.00 or both or Community Service for five (5) hours at the discretion of the Court.

Section 8. The PNP, Elected Barangay Officials and Barangay Tanod shall be the apprehending officers for the violators of the said ordinance.

Section 9. The ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days following its complete publication in the newspaper of general circulation in the province.
