RESOLVED, to approve, as it is hereby approved, Resolution No. 51-2005 containing therein Ordinance No. 3, S. 2005, to wit:

**ORDINANCE NO. 3
SERIES 2005**

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 1 S. 1991: RE: STRAY DOGS.”

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MONCADA, TARLAC

- T H A T -

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the **“Dog Rabies Eradication Ordinance of Moncada.”**

Section 2. Definition of Terms:

“Stray Dogs”- a dog which is on the loose prowling or private places or is not under the complete control of its owner

“Euthanasia”- the deliberate, painless killing of stray dogs in public places.

“Streets & Public Places”- includes national, municipality or barangay roads, parks, plazas, public markets and such other places open to the public.

“Private Places”- includes privately owned streets, yards, a rice fields of farmlands and lots owned by an individual other than the owner of the stray dog.

“Rabies”- the disease common among canines or dogs gone rabid.

“Immunize”- to render perpetually free of a disease by way of the vaccination of an antidote.

Section 3. To ensure a successful campaign in the eradication of rabies in dogs, and to promote the general health and welfare of the people, the Rural Health Units of Moncada are hereby deputized as lead agencies in the implementation of the rabies eradication program of the municipality and shall coordinate with other related agencies and all barangay officials for consolidation of cases on the incidence of rabies in the municipality, and to conduct investigations, studies, research and information & education campaign, with the end in view of coming up with solutions to the problems concomitant to the purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The Local Government Unit shall take extreme measures, through Euthanasia, to ensure public health and safety from rabid stray dogs.

Section 5. Any person who refuses to cooperate with or obstructs any Health Personnel or Worker from the performance of their duties as provided in this Ordinance shall be held liable for obstruction of government functions.

Section 6. Stray dog owners are liable to pay the amount of the medical expenses incurred by victims.

Section 7. Dog owners are required to have their dogs immunized at least once a year at their expense in order to prevent the occurrence of the disease.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
